This year, teachers interested in participating in the contest will submit a video (MP4 format) showcasing a product created by their students. Examples of possible submissions could include participation in community cultural events, performances (song, poem, dance), and artwork.

Selection of Winners and Prizes

Winners will be selected from the following categories:

- Elementary and Middle school (K-8)
- High school (9-12).

Prizes will be awarded accordingly:

- Grand prize for best overall submission = \$100 Gift Card
- 1st Place K-8 = \$50 Gift Card, 2nd Place K-8 = \$25 Gift Card
- 1st Place HS 9-12 = \$50 Gift Card, 2nd Place HS 9-12 = \$25 Gift Card

In addition, all teachers of Grand Prize student & 1st Place students will be awarded free registration to the TWLTA Annual Conference and invited to attend the awards dinner at no cost.
